

## Terms of Use of *MinAbs Online*

**Subscribers (institutional or individual) are not normally required to sign a contract. If you require a formal licensing agreement please contact the Mineralogical Society ([info@minersoc.org](mailto:info@minersoc.org)). All users are expected to abide by the terms of use outlined below.**

These are the terms under which the Mineralogical Society provides access to *MinAbs Online*. Please read these terms carefully before using *MinAbs Online*.

### **License**

Users are granted the non-exclusive and non-transferable right to access *MinAbs Online* under the terms of the License Agreement approved and signed by the subscriber or subscribing institution representative. Trial Users may access *MinAbs Online* for a limited period of time (not more than two weeks) for the purpose of determining its suitability for purchase. During the free trial period, the Trial User will be subject to the same Terms and Conditions as a paying subscriber. Any breach of this License will result in the immediate termination of access by the Mineralogical Society. Authorized users are employees, faculty, staff and students who are officially affiliated with the subscribing institution. Public access may also be provided from designated terminals within the subscribing institution's IP range. Networked access over different sites on the same campus may be arranged by agreement with the Mineralogical Society. ### **Permitted Use**

The User may make unlimited online use of the Content, including searching, displaying and viewing on-screen, and may download, print or e-mail retrieved Content for the purposes of research, teaching or private study and not for commercial use (see Prohibited Use). If, during use, any abstract, or part of the licensed material is quoted verbatim, the original source must be acknowledged.

### **Prohibited Use**

Systematic downloading and/or archiving, of a *MinAbs online* abstract is prohibited other than for classroom or instructional use. Users wishing to re-use articles or abstracts for purposes other than classroom or instructional use should contact the Mineralogical Society. Individual abstracts may not be used for the purposes of monetary reward by means of sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials, and may not be systematically supplied or distributed onward from the site of the User.

### **Username and Passwords**

The User may be allocated a personal username and password for the purpose of gaining access to *MinAbs Online*. Users must not pass such usernames and passwords onto any other individuals in an attempt to by-pass the registration or purchasing procedures for this product. Any such breach of this License will result in access being terminated for

the User concerned.
