

## **Instructions for authors of abstracts for the ‘AluSiV’ meeting**

### **Talks**

Talks by invited speakers will be 40-50 min long, by arrangement with the convenor.

Talks by others will be 20–30 min long including time for questions. You must specify the length of time you would like when submitting your abstract, longer times may be available by arrangement with the convenor.

### **Length of abstract**

Each abstract can be up to 1 A4 page long. There should be a 2.5 cm margin on all sides of the page. Use 11 pt Times New Roman as the font.

### **Abstract contents**

Your submission must include the following:

Title

Author names (surname first)

Author addresses (in full)

Author e-mail addresses (one per author)

Text

You may include a figure or a table (embedded in the text)

You may include a short list of references.

### **Figures**

Line diagrams and greyscale drawings must have a resolution of at least 600 dpi.

Photographs (halftones) must have a resolution of at least 300 dpi.

### **Submission of abstracts**

There are two means by which you can submit your abstract:

1. If you are using online registration, please attach the file for your abstract by clicking on the Browse button and locating the completed abstract on your computer's hard disk. *If you are not satisfied that this is the final version of your abstract, but wish to complete registration at this stage, please upload the current version of your abstract now. It will be possible to submit a revised abstract by emailing it to [Kevin@minersoc.org](mailto:Kevin@minersoc.org), before 1<sup>st</sup> August 2008. Kevin Murphy and Derek Bain ([d.bain@macaulay.ac.uk](mailto:d.bain@macaulay.ac.uk)) will be responsible for editing the abstract volume.*
2. If you are using the paper registration form, please send the completed form to the Mineralogical Society office (as outlined on the form) and send your abstract to [kevin@minersoc.org](mailto:kevin@minersoc.org) as an attachment to an email.
