

Instructions for authors of abstracts for the ‘New Views on the Earth’s Interior’ meeting

Talks

Delegates are invited to submit one abstract each, for either oral or poster presentation.

The Bullerwell lecture will be 60 min long including time for questions. Talks by all other speakers will be 20 min long, including time for questions.

Length of abstract

Each abstract may be up to 1 A4 page long. There should be a 2.5 cm margin on all sides of the page. Use 11 pt Times New Roman as the font.

Abstract contents

Your submission must include the following:

Title

Author names (forename, surname, ^{1,2,3}, etc to indicate address, * to indicate e-mail address of presenting author)

¹Author addresses (in full)

* Author e-mail address

Text

You may include a figure or a table (embedded in the text)

You may include a short list of references.

Figures

Line diagrams and greyscale drawings must have a resolution of at least 600 dpi.

Photographs (halftones) must have a resolution of at least 300 dpi.

Submission of abstracts

There are two means by which you can submit your abstract:

1. If you are using online registration, please attach the file for your abstract by clicking on the Browse button and locating the completed abstract on your computer’s hard disk. *If you are not satisfied that this is the final version of your abstract, but wish to complete registration at this stage, please upload the current version of your abstract now. It will be possible to submit a revised abstract by emailing it to Kevin@minersoc.org, before 19th December 2008.*
2. If you are using the paper registration form, please send the completed form to the Mineralogical Society office (as outlined on the form) and send your abstract to kevin@minersoc.org as an attachment to an email.
